

## **AVERT Instructor Course Information**

*Please review this document for your upcoming course. Below, you will find frequently asked questions to help you arrive equipped with the latest knowledge and the confidence you need to succeed.*

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**Q: What should I wear?**

**A:** Dress comfortably. You will be moving around the room during skills practice.

**Q: What materials do I receive in the course?**

**A:** You will receive your digital Instructor Manual, **AVERT** Instructor training kit (see below) disposable gloves and gauze for use in class.

**Q: What do I need to bring?**

**A:** Unless otherwise specified, you are not required to bring anything additional to your class. You may bring a pen and notepad to take notes.

**Q: What happens if I am late?**

**A:** Please make every effort to arrive on time. Depending on the circumstances and how late you arrive, you may be able to make up missed time with the Instructor Trainer (IT). You are provided with the IT's cell phone number. Please maintain communication if you are not going to be on time. **If you are 30 minutes or more late, you will not be admitted and will have to attend a class at a later date.**

**Q: What happens if I don't pass the class?**

**A:** It is our objective to train and certify successful instructors, and sometimes that takes more than one training session to accomplish. Your IT will discuss the areas that need additional training before you leave class. In the week following the class, a representative from ProSafety or HSI will contact you with additional training options.



## ProSafety **AVERT** Instructor Development Course

This instructor course by the Health & Safety Institute (HSI) & **The ProSafety Training Center** is designed to allow the participant to teach the **AVERT** course. This course includes all of the materials needed to teach the course, once completed.

### **What is AVERT:**

**AVERT** combines active shooter and bleeding control training to give you and your team the skills you need in almost any emergency situation. With **AVERT** training, you will learn how to recognize the signs of danger, react appropriately, and make rapid survival decisions under realistic circumstances.

### **There are 3 steps to completing the AVERT Instructor course:**

1. Complete the **AVERT IDC** Registration form and return to ProSafety.
2. Complete the required 2 hour online **AVERT** Instructor Blended Learning course.
3. The Instructor Trainer-led AVERT course will take six (6) hours for successful completion.

### ***Once you have registered and paid for the course, you will receive the following:***

**AVERT** Instructor Blended Learning online course. This will be emailed to you.

**AVERT** Instructor Trainer Kit. This will be shipped to you. The kit includes the following items:

- 1 Tactical Carry Case
- 1 Training Long Gun
- 1 Training Hand Gun
- 15 C-A-T Practice Tourniquets
- 15 Wound Packing Simulators
- 10 Practice Throwing Objects
- Practice Gauze
- A Seat in the **AVERT** Instructor course.
